

Prescott Public Library Viewerie

The Guild puts up a display at the Prescott Public Library Viewerie every October. The Viewerie is a large showcase that the library makes available to public groups throughout the year. Our display celebrates “National Spinning and Weaving Week” and highlights our Guild. Our display is shown throughout the month of October. There is no cost to display in the Viewerie.

The Guild currently reserves 1/3 of the space, which is approximately 10 feet long, 4 feet deep and 10 feet high, and provides enough room for a small loom, one or two spinning wheels and displays of our craft. This is a locked, secure space.

The 2nd Vice President is responsible for coordinating the display. A Chairperson may be selected to handle the display, or the 2nd Vice President may have to be the Chair if no one volunteers.

Members are asked to participate by loaning items for use in the display and by helping to set up and take down the display.
